We need to replace the roof slates on our home (a late-19th-century property, divided into two dwellings, in Newhaven and within a Conservation Area) due to leaks. The existing Scots slates are believed to be original and are approaching the end of their serviceable life, with over 80% requiring replacement. No alterations are proposed to the roof structure, detailing and overall appearance. Our roofer proposes using Spanish heavy slate as an appropriate substitute for Scots slate.
